Course Description

- The aim of the A220 Type Specific Cabin Training is to provide airline personnel with information and operational instructions on A220 aircraft and related cabin systems for a successful Entry Into Service (EIS). The two-day training, conducted by our qualified Cabin Crew Instructors, mixes a well-balanced content of theoretical and practical training based on the idea of theoretical foundation training in the classroom, along with Web Based training and daily session on our state-of-the-art Cabin Crew Emergency Evacuation Trainer – from door operation (normal & emergency) to slide decent, and cabin system operation.
